On January 31, 2005, the Securities Division, Department of Financial Institutions, Washington 8 State, ("the Securities Division") entered Statement of Charges And Notice of Intent to Enter an Order to 9 Cease and Desist and to Impose Costs and Fines, Order Number S-05-256-04-SC01, ("Statement of 10 Charges") against Respondents, Delaware Investments, Inc. and Charles Park, Pursuant to the Securities 11 Act of Washington, RCW 21.20, the Securities Division of the Department of Financial Institutions 12 ("Securities Division") and Respondents, Delaware Investments, Inc. and Charles Park, do hereby enter 13 into this CONSENT ORDER in settlement of the above captioned matter. In the Statement of Charges, 14 the Securities Division made certain allegations and conclusions, set forth under the headings of 15 "Tentative Findings of Facts" and "Conclusions of Law." ## **CONSENT ORDER**

Based upon the foregoing:

IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents, Delaware Investments, Inc. and Charles Park, their agents and employees each shall cease and desist from offering or selling securities in violations of RCW 21.20.140, the securities registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents, Delaware Investments, Inc. and Charles Park, their agents and employees each shall cease and desist from acting as an unregistered securities broker-dealer or salesperson in violation of RCW 21.20.040, the broker-dealer and securities salesperson registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents, Delaware Investments, Inc. and
 Charles Park, their agents and employees each shall cease and desist from violating RCW 21.20.010, the
 anti-fraud section of the Securities Act of Washington.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Charles Park shall pay a fine of
\$20,000 on or before the date of entry of this order.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent Charles Park shall pay to the
 Securities Division the costs, fees, and other expenses incurred in the investigation and prosecution of
 this matter in the amount of \$1,500 on or before the date of entry of this order.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Securities Division has jurisdiction to enter this Order.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that in consideration of the foregoing, Delaware Investments, Inc. and Charles Park each waives their rights to a hearing in this matter and judicial review of this matter
