IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Biotech cancel the 783,543 shares, that directors Ray G. Bohn, Kenneth W. Brownfield, and John R. Ryan obtained in violation of RCW 21.20.010.

IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents cease and desist from sales of unregistered securities in violation of RCW 21.20.140.

IT IS ALSO AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents cease and desist from acting as an unregistered securities broker/dealer or salesperson in violation of RCW 21.20.040.

IT IS ALSO AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents cease and desist from violations of RCW 21.20.010.

In consideration of the foregoing, Respondents withdraw their request for hearing and waives their right to a hearing on this matter.
