STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Please take notice that the Securities Administrator of the State of Washington has reason to believe that Respondents, Nick Caro, Albert Bowen, and New Vision ATM, Inc. have violated the Securities Act of Washington and that their violations justify the entry of an order of the Securities Administrator under RCW 21.20.390 to cease and desist from such violations. The Securities Administrator finds that delay in ordering the Respondents to cease and desist from such violations would be hazardous to the investors and to the public and that a Summary Order to Cease and Desist should be entered immediately. The Securities Administrator finds as follows:

TENTATIVE FINDINGS OF FACT

I. RESPONDENTS

- 1. NEW VISION ATM, INC. ("New Vision") is a California corporation that purchases, places, and operates Automatic Teller Machines ("ATM's") for profit. New Vision also promotes and sells interests in "corporation units" of New Vision ATM, Inc. through its' "Corporate Note Program and Profit Participation" plan. New Vision has as a place of business at 1101 California Ave., Suite 100, Corona, CA.
- 2. ALBERT BOWEN ("Bowen") is the president of New Vision ATM, Inc.

3. NICK CARO ("Caro") is the vice-president of marketing for New Vision ATM, Inc. Acting as an agent of New Vision, Caro offered and sold interests in "corporation units" of New Vision ATM, Inc. to at least one Washington resident.

II. NATURE OF OFFERING

From May of 1999 until at least July of 1999, Respondents acting in concert, on behalf of one another, and acting through their agent Nick Caro, solicited at least one Washington resident to invest in "corporation units" of New Vision through its "Corporate Note Program and Profit Participation" plan. Caro made oral representations to the investor that New Vision was raising capital for the purposes of purchasing, placing, and operating ATM's in casinos and hotels in Las Vegas, Nevada, and other locations nationwide. In offering literature mailed to the investor, the investment was described as "no liability, no risk, no confusion."

In connection with this investment, the investor entered into an acceptance agreement with New Vision. New Vision also gave the investor a corporate note in representation of this investment. New Vision's "corporation units" were priced at \$10,000 per unit. Under the terms of the acceptance agreement signed by the investor, New Vision guaranteed an annual rate of return at between 12 % to 15 % on a 12 month corporate note, with interest to be paid on a quarterly basis. New Vision also guaranteed the investor a share of the corporate profits under terms described in the acceptance agreement.

A Washington resident invested \$5,000 in May of 1999, and another \$5,000 in August of 1999, to acquire a total of one "corporate unit" in New Vision. Through October of 1999, Nick Caro, acting on behalf of New Vision ATM, Inc., continued to offer the Washington resident additional interests in New Vision, along with other related investments.

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III. MISREPRESENTATIONS AND OMISSIONS

Respondents Nick Caro, Albert Bowen, and New Vision ATM, Inc. failed to provide a Washington investor with a disclosure document containing complete material information about the investment described in paragraphs I and II, including but not limited to risk factor disclosure and financial statements of New Vision ATM, Inc.

IV. REGISTRATION STATUS

The offer and sale of the investments described in paragraphs I and II are not currently registered in the State of Washington and have not previously been so registered.

Nick Caro, Albert Bowen, and New Vision ATM, Inc. are not currently registered as securities salespersons or broker-dealers in the State of Washington and have not previously been so registered.

Based upon the above Tentative Findings of Fact, the following Conclusions of Law are made:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

I.

The offer and/or sale of interests in New Vision ATM, Inc. as described above constitutes the offer and/or sale of a security as defined in RCW 21.20.005(10) and (12), to wit: a note; evidence of indebtedness; an investment contract; or risk capital.

II.

The offer and/or sale of said securities was made in violation of RCW 21.20.010 because Respondents failed to provide prospective purchasers a complete disclosure document containing complete material information regarding the investment, including but not limited to risk factor disclosure and financial statements of the issuer.

III.

The offer and/or sale of said securities is in violation of RCW 21.20.140 because no registration for such offer and/or sale is on file with the Securities Administrator of the state of Washington.

IV.

Respondents have violated RCW 21.20.040 by offering and/or selling said securities while not registered

as a securities salesperson, broker-dealer, or investment adviser in the state of Washington.

V.

The Securities Administrator finds that an emergency exists and that the continued violations of RCW 21.20.010, RCW 21.20.140, and RCW 21.20.040, constitute a threat to the investing public. Accordingly, a Summary Order to Cease and Desist from those violations is in the public interest and necessary for the protection of the investing public.

SUMMARY ORDER

Based upon foregoing, NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY SUMMARILY ORDERED that Nick Caro, Albert Bowen, New Vision ATM, Inc., and their agents and employees each cease and desist from violating RCW 21.20.010, the anti-fraud section of the Securities Act.

It is further SUMMARILY ORDERED that Respondents, Nick Caro, Albert Bowen, New Vision ATM, Inc., and their agents and employees each cease and desist from violating RCW 21.20.140 by offering and/or selling unregistered securities.

It is further SUMMARILY ORDERED Nick Caro, Albert Bowen, and New Vision ATM, Inc., and their agents and employees each cease and desist from violating RCW 21.20.040 by acting as a securities broker-dealer or securities salesperson without being so registered.

AUTHORITY AND PROCEDURE

This Order is entered pursuant to the provisions of RCW 21.20.390, and is subject to the provisions of Chapter 34.05 RCW. Each of the Respondents may make a written request for a hearing as set forth in the NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO DEFEND AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING accompanying this Order.

If a Respondent does not request a hearing, the Securities Administrator intends to adopt the above Tentative Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as final and make the Summary Order to Cease and Desist permanent as to that Respondent.
